LAST WEEK OF VOTING

As you will no doubt be aware, the referendum ends at 10pm on Thursday 11th December. Figures released by the Returning Officer show that the turnout so far has been low across all 10 districts, but The Yes Campaign are continuing to have a presence at transport hubs across Greater Manchester to make sure people don't miss this opportunity to give our public transport system the investment it deserves.

In a final push to get out the vote, next Monday (8 December) will be 'Mega Monday'. Over 100 volunteers, including pensioners, students, environmentalists and local business people, will be at bus stops and train stations handing out 'Final Week' leaflets with the message 'There's still time to Vote YES for lower bus fares, lower tram fares and more trains.'
